

Public Wifi Hotspot Now Available in Jamestown Market



Cable & Wireless has continued roll-out of Wifi Hotspots with the installation of a Wifi Hotspot in **Ardee's Café** in the Jamestown Market. The facility will enable the public and stall holders to access the internet from anywhere within the Market.

There are two Wifi access options available. Existing Broadband customers will be able to logon using their Broadband Account details and usage will be deducted from their data bank. Occasional users can purchase per minute access by means of an account generator from Ardee's for connectivity to the Market Hotspot.

"This should be a good thing for the Café and other stall holders, whereby word will get around and help boost sales. I would like to hope that this will happen with the extra people on the Island during the festive season"

Cable & Wireless currently has a public Wifi Hotspot at Ann's Place in Castle Gardens. In addition, there are Wifi Hotspots in Harris's Guest House and the Consulate Hotel for use by their guests. The Company also has plans to install a further Hotspot in the harbour area.
